Additional information: Please bring your recess and lunch and ensure you have a drink bottle to use during the games throughout the day.

Spectators are welcome. As this is a **selected** school **Northern NSW Futsal side** in a knockout competition, **game time for each child will vary**. As it is a competitive game of futsal, the coach of either team **should not be approached** during game time and all parents and spectators will support their child in the designated spectator's area.
