Dear Parents and Carers

Only 2 weeks until our first performance! Attached to this note is some very important information from the organisers of Star Struck. Please read this carefully to ensure you are informed about drop off and pick up zones.

What: Friday Evening Performance.

Where: Newcastle Entertainment Centre.

When: Friday 16th June.

**Travel**: Students are to be dropped off and picked up from the Entertainment Centre.

**Time:** Meet Miss Opazo and Mrs Gigengack at <u>Flag T</u> (located on grassed area near the centre ring) <u>at</u> **5:45pm**, and **9:30pm for pick up.** 

What: Saturday Matinee Performance.

Where: Newcastle Entertainment Centre.

When: Saturday 17th June.

**Travel**: Students are to be dropped off and picked up from the Entertainment Centre.

**Time:** Meet Miss Opazo and Mrs Gigengack at <u>Flag T</u> (located on grassed area near the centre ring) <u>at</u> <u>11:45am</u> and <u>4:00pm for pick up.</u>







### **DROP OFF AND PICK UP ARRANGEMENTS**

<u>For both the Friday evening show and the Saturday matinee show</u>, parents are to drop off and pick up their child from the designated zone - <u>flag T</u> located on the grassed area near the centre ring. Please ensure you see the teachers to sign your child in and out.

### What to Wear

When arriving to both performances, students need to wear their Star Struck t-shirt with black leggings and black shoes, this is also their finale costume.

### Costume

Your costumes will be taken to both performances by the teachers. You will be able to take it all home after show week if they have been paid for in full. Please ensure you have provided black ankle socks and black canvas shoes/jazz shoes. We recommend the children wear tan underwear for underneath their costumes.

## Hair and Make up:

Please arrive to both performances with your hair and make up done. Dance stage make-up is required. Girls are required to wear eyeshadow, blush, foundation, mascara and red lipstick. We recommend neutral tones for eyeshadow and blush. Boys are not required to wear makeup.

Students may bring their make up to touch it up, please ensure everything is in a zip lock bag and marked with their name. *There will be no sharing of make up*.


**Bring**: Hairspray/gel, elastics, bobby pins (teachers need to adjust hair for their second dance), brush, make up, a warm jacket to wear in between dances (zip up is preferred). They can bring a blanket to sit on/share with a friend as it does get cold in the holding rooms. Don't forget snacks and water.
