Industrial Action TOMORROW

As communicated via yesterday's note, the NSW Teachers' Federation has called teacher members to attend a meeting tomorrow morning at locations throughout the state. Many Tanilba Bay teachers will be attending this meeting.

The school will be open and operational at its usual time tomorrow, but with reduced supervision. Children arriving at school at their regular time should go directly to the Hall, where available staff will be allocated to provide supervised activities.

Normal school operations will resume at 10.30am, at which time students will go to their classrooms for a roll call. Our concern is to make sure that all students are safely accounted for, so will have the following procedures in place:

- Students arriving at their regular time (8.30-9.05) are to go directly to the Hall, where they will be signed in

- Students arriving between 9.00-10.30am must also go to the Hall
- Students arriving at 10.30 may go directly to their classrooms
- Any child arriving after 11.00 must be signed in at the office as a late arrival.

Any child who is away from school tomorrow due to industrial action will not have that absence recorded as Late/Unjustified. The Department of Education has a special code for industrial action, so such absences don't go on children's records.

Both Ms Sawyer and Mr Harris will be on site tomorrow morning, so if you have any questions or concerns don't hesitate to ask.

Celebrate!

We're excited as Celebrate! Is just around the corner. Here's the NEED-TO-KNOW list:

- This year's Performance Night is outdoors, on Oval 1
- Gates open at 4.45pm – please do not arrive before then
- One entrance only, large car park gate at the front of the school
- The back gate will not be open on Celebrate! Night – parking will be available in the Habitat by special arrangement or park on the foreshore and saunter along the boardwalk (Do not park in No Standing zones or driveways)
- Security on the gate to check that no alcohol is brought onto the school site
- Celebrate! kicks off at 5.30pm, with Early Stage 1 and Stage 1 students performing first
- Early Stage 1 and Stage 1 students are to arrive between 5.00-5.15pm, and be taken by their parent/carer straight to the classroom, where they will be signed in
- Students sit with their class and teacher until after their whole stage performs
- After ES1 and S1 finish performing, children will move to the Basketball Court, where they are to be signed out by their parent/carer
- After signed out, your child is under your supervision – please keep them with you to enjoy the rest of the show, or keep track if they go to food stall or adventure playground, as classrooms and Oval 2 are out of bounds during performances.
- The show will be finished and everyone off the grounds by 8.00pm
- There are no tickets and the show is being provided by the school free-of-charge as a gift to our school community
- Bring a picnic rug, camp chairs etc to sit on – there will be minimal seating provided as it's a relaxed outdoor event
- The school is providing costumes, props etc
- Bring a picnic or some \$ to buy from the food stall, manned by our local Lions Club
- **Event is ALCOHOL and SMOKE-FREE (Illegal to have alcohol or smoke on site – security will be on the gate to check)**
- There will be a display in the Hall of artworks and other products from Stage 3 electives – this area is out of bounds to students unless accompanied by a parent/carer
- Student toilets will be open for children's use only. Adults may use the Porta-Loos that will be provided or the Disabled Toilet across from the Hall.

Our teachers are excited about presenting our performance night in this new format and hope you have a great night.

THE DAY AFTER: Transition Visits and Jump Rope

In case your child is tempted to sleep in post-Celebrate! they need to know that the day after, Friday, is the day we will be having our Transition Visits. In the morning, children will go to meet their 2020 teachers and spend some time in their new classrooms. In the middle session, we will have our annual JUMP ROPER FOR HEART exhibition. Parents wishing to check it out should arrive at 11.30am for a 11.40 start.
