Bus Matters: Tap On, Tap Off

Does your child have their OPAL Card? All students using the bus service need a free OPAL Card to tap on and off. The information from the cards is used to decide how many buses are needed. If cards are tapped on/off, the bus company has no way to prove that the bus is being used.

I am in touch with the bus company regularly, and am always glad to hear that Tanilba Bay students are mostly well behaved on the bus. However, there have also been some less positive incidents on the bus lately. When things go wrong on the bus, we work together with the bus company to make sure all children are safe.

Students who get physical on the bus or misbehave in other serious ways run the risk of being suspended from the bus. Ms Sawyer and Mr Gattenhof met with all students who travel on the bus today. At the meeting, the teachers thanked students who are both friendly and safe on the bus. The children and teachers also talked about the importance of standing up for what is right – telling Mum/Dad or a teacher whenever someone is not doing the right thing on the bus.

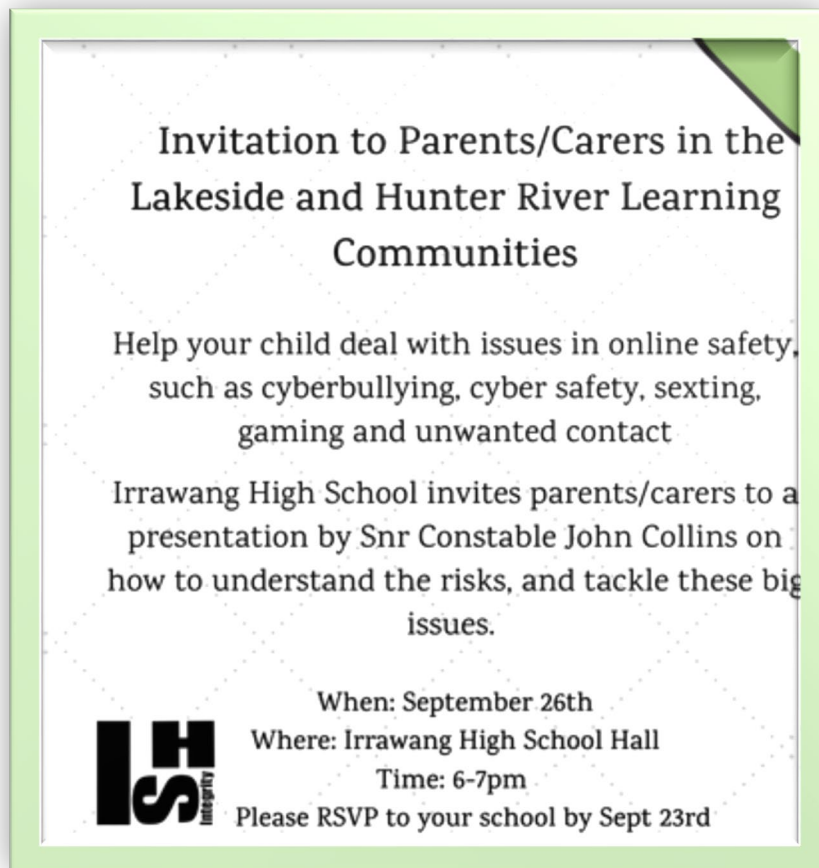
