This week, teachers sat down at their regular Professional Learning meeting and took a close look at our school learning data. While we have achieved some improvements this year, we still have a lot of work to do. We are committed to improving Literacy and Numeracy outcomes for our students and trying lots of strategies. We are so grateful for your support and the very hard work of our teachers.

TTFM is a very important opportunity for the community to provide the school with feedback. We strongly encourage your to complete a survey as we rely on your input to make important decisions.


